## The 15 Best Destination Spas Around the World

If you're looking for serenity in 2024, check out these top destination spas.

• Why we love it: A time-honored wellness sanctuary

Founded by Deborah and Edmond Szekely in 1940 in Tecate, Mexico, as a summer health camp, Rancho La Puerta has grown into an acclaimed wellness destination. As a guest, you're not just visiting a spa; you're immersing yourself in a legacy that's been nurtured by the Szekely family for generations. The motto is "siempre mejor" or "always better," and the property is committed to helping people live healthier and happier lives.

Guests stay in one of the 86 casitas adorned with vibrant Mexican textiles and terra-cotta tile floors. Physical activity is a key component of the experience, with a daily roster of optional activities like hiking, qi gong, kickboxing, and cycling, all surrounded by 4,000 acres of natural beauty. Rancho La Puerta's commitment to the environment shows in its sustainable practices, including water conservation and green construction. And Rancho La Puerta keeps evolving—look for Mayan-style Cacao Ceremonies during full moons, new women's retreats focused on menopause, and residences for sale in a new private village if you don't ever want to leave.
